# **Bivalirudin Intravenous for Adults**



## Who can administer

Administration RESTRICTED - see Appendix 1

## Important information

- May be used only in Cardiothoracic surgery on Consultant advice
- Unlicensed preparation in Ireland
- IMPORTANT: The ACT is NOT the same as the APTT. Results are not interchangeable.

### Available preparations

Bivalirudin 250mg vial

### Reconstitution

#### Water for injection

- Add 5mL per 250mg vial
- Swirl gently until fully dissolved and the solution is clear
- Reconstitution may take 3 to 4 minutes to be complete
- Dilute further prior to administration
- Take 5mL (250mg) of reconstitution solution and add to 45mL infusion fluid to produce a 5mg per mL solution- this diluted solution is used for both the bolus dose and the infusion <sup>(ref 1)</sup>

## Infusion fluids

Glucose 5% or Sodium Chloride 0.9%

### Methods of intravenous administration

#### Bolus intravenous injection (Cardiac surgery)

• Administer required dose as a rapid IV push

#### Continuous intravenous infusion (Cardiac surgery)

- Using a 5mg per ml solution (250mg in 50mL) set up the continuous infusion
- Adjust dose as per Q pulse document

### Dose in adults

#### GUH: Only used in Cardiothoracic surgery
